Policies and Governance Working Group

Objective: Recommend policies and procedures related to the use of GenAl in state executive-branch agencies. Develop a governance framework that outlines the policies, procedures, and processes for developing, deploying, and using GenAl.

Deliverables:

- Policies and governance tied to GenAl.
- Procurement and development guidelines.
- Authorization to operate (ATO) process for GenAI systems.
- Guidelines for sandbox environments.

Focus Areas:

- Defining Terms define "generative AI" and other key concepts in the regulatory space for Alabama.
- Data Usage setting out how data is used and managed in GenAI systems.
 - \circ Articulate who is responsible for data ownership, management, and privacy.
 - o Define permissible data usage for developing and training GenAI systems and models.
- Risk Management defining risks associated with government use of GenAI and monitoring needed to ensure responsible use by government entities.
 - Authorization to Operate (ATO) setting out minimum requirements that must be met prior to procuring or deploying GenAI in state systems.
 - Defining terms of acceptable use.
- Alignment with existing governance examining terms of existing GenAI governance systems and frameworks used by state and federal government entities.
 - $\circ~$ Establish parameters for Alabama policies using frameworks that have succeeded in other areas.
 - Determine state agencies' current requirements under existing frameworks and develop requirements for indicating compliance.

Executive Order 738 Objectives

- Encourage the responsible and effective use of GenAl in state executive-branch agencies.
- Recommend policies and procedures related to the use of GenAl in state executivebranch agencies.
- Study, evaluate, and develop policy and administrative recommendations related to the responsible deployment of GenAI in state government.
- Develop a set of principles and values that will guide the development and use of GenAI within state government.
- Develop a governance framework that outlines the policies, procedures, and processes for the development, deployment, and use of GenAI in the areas of:
 - o Data Management
 - Model Development
 - o Model Monitoring
 - o Human Oversight
- Advise the Office of Information Technology as the agency establishes the cloud infrastructure to allow states agencies to safely and responsibly conduct GenAI pilot projects.
- Additional recommendations for further executive action or legislation.
